- To secure the exchange of knowledge and experience through meetings and participation in international conference and meetings



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The Danish Bentley User Community (TMC-DIB)

- Independent of Bentley
- 65 different companies in Denmark, all paying a member fee of 2.500,- DK/year per company
- The Community has a organisation with a chairman, vice chairman, secretary, accountant and a webmaster
- SIG for MicroStation, Building, GIS, Plant, Civil, Project Management, Plot and 3D Viz

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The Civil SIG User Group

- All civil CAD products, not only from Bentley, but we normally have focus on InRoads and InRail
- The Civil SIG meets 3-4 times a year
- Danish annual meeting, SIG day, Nordic, BE and InRoads Civil User Conference in US
- This year we was around 25 people (6-7 civil) from Denmark at the BE2005 in Baltimore and 2 users at the InRoads User Conference in Denver



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Typical SIG meeting

- Welcome and presentation of the participants and the host company
- Appointing of a person to make a minute of the meeting
- Approval of the minute from the last meeting
- General orientation
- The subject(s) of the day
- Change Requests
- Questions, etc.
- Next meeting, subject, date, time and place



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Working together

- Getting a closer contract to Bentley support and development teams in US
- Easy to contract the staff a Bentley, when you have met the guys face to face
- CR system with a follow up-procedure, that insure the Bentley staff understand our CR and problems
- Working together to better solution (ex. the new roundabout and junction tools, standards etc.)
- More people - stronger voice
